Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill eliminates the booth rental permit requirement.

The booth rental permit fee is \$100 for a two-year permit. The Barber Board issues approximately 175 booth rental permits in the first year of the renewal cycle at \$100 each and approximately 35 at \$50 each in the second year of the renewal cycle. The revenue loss would be \$17,500 in FY 2023 and \$1,750 in FY 2024.

The Barber Board has a sufficient cash fund balance to handle the revenue loss without raising fees in the next two fiscal years. The beginning balance in FY 2021 was \$159,636 and the ending balance was \$151,111. Annual revenue was \$128,220 and expenses were \$136,745.
