Explanation of Estimate:

LB87 allows persons eighteen years of age and older to make health care decisions and persons under nineteen years of age in correctional facilities to consent to their own medical and mental health care.

Child and Family Services (CFS) acts as the legal custodian to youth who are state wards. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is financially responsible for youth and services while the youth is in State's custody. If youth make their own healthcare decisions, without the consent of CFS, the fiscal impact tied to the healthcare decisions would be the responsibility of CFS. The total amount is indeterminable, but it could be substantial. The total amount for each case could be unknown to CFS until after healthcare procedures are completed. Some of these medical services could be covered under Medicaid or the youth's private health insurance if applicable. There are several scenarios where costs would not be covered by Medicaid. This includes if the proper authorizations were not obtained prior to a procedure occurring, if the medical procedure is outside of what the youth's insurance covers, or if the youth does not have any insurance. Ultimately, DHHS could be financially responsible.

The total fiscal impact is currently indeterminable.
