LB 263 would allow the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to make minor modifications to permit applications approved under the Integrated Solid Waste Mangement Act without a public notice or hearing. LB 263 also defines the type of actions that would be considered minor modifications. It is estimated that the provisions of LB 263 would result in a small amount of cash fund savings because DEQ would not be required to issue public notices or hold hearings for minor modifications in approved permit applications. There is no basis to disagree with the agency estimate that approximately \$3,000 in cash funds would not be used for this purpose, and could be redirected towards other division activities or state aid payments.
