This bill allows two persons, regardless of marital status, to jointly adopt a minor child. Any parent may consent to the adoption of a minor child by the parent's spouse or other adult who will share parental responsibility for the child with such parent, without the parent having to relinquish his or her legal rights to the child.

Computer programming changes would need to be made for both vital records and N-Focus to accommodate the addition of more than one legal father or mother. The cost of those changes is unknown at this time.
