LB 1082 would provide insurance coverage for in vitro fertilization uniformly to all employees covered by the Nebraska State Insurance Plan.

The bill would require the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to contract with a vendor to provide a new plan for this coverage separate from the State's current healthcare plans. State employees would cover the full cost of the premium. DAS would be able to absorb the costs of the contracting efforts and administration of the additional special coverage to the state's healthcare plans.

There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

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Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1082 relates to the Nebraska State Insurance Program and proposes to provide for in vitro fertilization as a special coverage made available uniformly to all employees beginning July 1, 2024.

As written, this bill creates a new plan, separate from the State's current health plans in which the State of Nebraska employees would cover the full cost of the premium. The State of Nebraska pays no part of premiums on plans under sections 84-1607 to 84-1609 for special coverages, i.e., dental and disability insurance, accidental death, and dismemberment benefits, disability income replacement benefits and the extension to cover dependents. As with other special coverages, to implement LB 1082 the State of Nebraska would contract with a vendor to administer the plan. The contracting efforts and ongoing plan administration of the additional special coverage to the state's health plans could be completed with existing resources.

LB1082, as written, has a modest fiscal impact to the State of Nebraska health plans that could be absorbed by the agency.
