This bill establishes the Nebraska Women, Infants, and Children Program Advisory Board. The board consists of 17 members appointed by the governor. The board is required to meet twice annually to review the status of the WIC Program. The board is required to issue an annual report.

Board members would be reimbursed for travel costs. The costs would depend on the geographic area the board members are from. Based on the average reimbursement for the Behavioral Health Commission, the cost would range between \$1,000 and \$2,000 annually.
