LB 292 is the Nebraska Uniform Athlete Agents Act.

Section 4 prohibits an individual from acting as an athlete agent without holding a certificate of registration.

Section 6 requires the Secretary of State to issue certificates of registration and renewals to individuals who comply with the provisions of the act.

Section 9 requires applications to be accompanied by fees for application or renewal. The fees shall be established by the Secretary of State by rule and regulation at a rate sufficient to cover the costs of administering the Act.

The Secretary of State estimates the need for minimal spending authority to address the provisions of the bill. Their estimates appear to be reasonable.
