LB 621 establishes a new fine of \$300 for traveling over 35 miles per hour over the authorized speed limit. The current fine is \$200 for such violation. The bill also changes the point system for traffic violations for persons exceeding the speed limit by more than 35 miles per hour. The points are changed from three points to four points for such violation.

The Department of Motor Vehicles will need to reprogram the traffic violation point system to reflect the change. DMV indicates the programming change can be accomplished with existing resources. Any increase in fine revenue pursuant to the bill will accrue to the political subdivision where the violation occurred for use by the public schools.
