LB 805 pertains to motor vehicle statutes. The bill, as amended, includes the provisions of several bills pertaining to motor vehicles. The provisions of the bill (Section 6) related to LB 761 are the only sections which appear to have a fiscal impact. These sections prohibit the issuance of an employment driving permit to persons whose licenses have been revoked due to driving under the influence convictions, if one or more administrative license revocations have been issued during the immediately preceding 12 year period.

The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) indicates there were 637employment driving permits issued in 2008. DMV does not currently track information regarding whether employment driving permits are issued to persons with one or more license revocations in the immediately preceding 12 years. The department will have minimal increased programming expenses related to tracking the issuance of employment driving permits in accordance with the bill. Any expenses can be handled with the existing resources of the department.

The fee for an employment driving permit is \$47.50, of which \$40 is deposited in the General Fund and \$7.50 accrues to the DMV Cash Fund. There will be a minimal loss in revenue from employment driving permits pursuant to the bill for those persons who will be prohibited from obtaining a permit. The number of persons impacted by the bill is estimated to be small, so the estimated loss in revenue is projected to be minimal for the General Fund and DMV Cash Fund.
