LB 484 would have no fiscal impact to state agencies.

LB 484 would require county treasurers to pay tax proceeds collected on behalf of county agricultural societies and rural or suburban fire districts on or before the fifteenth day of each month. Current law does not specify a date for payment to county agricultural societies and states that rural or suburban fire districts must apply for payment of tax collections from the county treasurer. It is estimated that the specification of a payment date would have no significant fiscal impact to counties, nor would it affect the amount of revenue received by county agricultural societies or rural or suburban fire districts.
