LB 788 would amend the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 53-103 and 53-125 regarding the provisions for managers.

The bill changes the residency and citizenship requirements for managers to require that they are the same as for applicants for a liquor license. An applicant for a Nebraska liquor license must be a resident of Nebraska and a citizen of the United States.

The bill also amends language regarding corporations to clarify that a corporation will not be issued a license if the manager of a corporate license would be ineligible to receive a license under that section.

The Liquor Control Commission indicates that LB 788 has no fiscal impact.

There is no basis to disagree with the Liquor Control Commission's estimate of fiscal impact.
