- Sec. 41. Section 60-4,115, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 4 60-4,115 (1) Fees for operators' licenses and state identification 5 cards shall be collected by department personnel or the county treasurer and distributed according to the table in subsection (2) of this section, 6 except for the ignition interlock permit and associated fees as outlined 7 in subsection (4) of this section and the 24/7 sobriety program permit 8 9 and associated fees as outlined in subsection (5) of this section. County officials shall remit the county portion of the fees collected to the 10 county treasurer for placement in the county general fund. All other fees 11 12 collected shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the appropriate fund. 13
- 14 (2) The fees provided in this subsection in the following dollar 15 amounts apply for operators' licenses and state identification cards.

- 5 identification card and collects the fees, the department shall remit the
- 6 county portion of the fees to the State Treasurer for credit to the
- 7 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 8 (4)(a) The fee for an ignition interlock permit shall be forty-five
- 9 dollars. Five dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
- 10 for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Forty dollars
- 11 of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
- 12 Department of Motor Vehicles Ignition Interlock Fund.
- 13 (b) The fee for a replacement ignition interlock permit shall be
- 14 eleven dollars. Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be
- 15 remitted to the county treasurer for credit to the county general fund.
- 16 Six dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for
- 17 credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Two dollars and
- 18 twenty-five cents of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for
- 19 credit to the General Fund.
- 20 (c) The fee for adding, changing, or removing a class, endorsement,
- 21 or restriction on an ignition interlock permit shall be five dollars. The
- 22 fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department
- 23 of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 24 (5)(a) The fee for a 24/7 sobriety program permit shall be forty-
- 25 five dollars. Twenty-five dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the
- 26 State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 27 Fifteen dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for
- 28 credit to the General Fund. Five dollars of the fee shall be remitted to
- 29 the <u>county treasurer</u> State Treasurer for credit to the county general
- 30 fund of the participant's county of residence.

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- (b) The fee for a replacement 24/7 sobriety program permit shall be eleven dollars. Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be remitted to the county treasurer for credit to the county general fund—of the participant's county of residence. Six dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Two dollars and twenty-five cents of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund.
- 8 (c) The fee for adding, changing, or removing a class, endorsement,
  9 or restriction on a 24/7 sobriety program permit shall be five dollars.
  10 The fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
  11 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 12 (6) The department and its agents may collect an identity security surcharge to cover the cost of security and technology practices used to 13 14 protect the identity of applicants for and holders of operators' licenses 15 and state identification cards and to reduce identity theft, fraud, and forgery and counterfeiting of such licenses and cards to the maximum 16 17 extent possible. The surcharge shall be in addition to all other required fees for operators' licenses and state identification cards. The amount 18 of the surcharge shall be determined by the department. The surcharge 19 shall not exceed eight dollars. The surcharge shall be remitted to the 20 21 State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- Sec. 52. Section 60-1515, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 24 60-1515 (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that a statewide system for the collection, storage, and transfer of data on 25 26 vehicle titles and registration and the cooperation of state and local 27 government in implementing such a system is essential to the efficient operation of state and local government in vehicle titling 28 29 registration. The Legislature hereby finds and declares that the 30 electronic issuance of operators' licenses and state identification cards using a digital system as described in section 60-484.01 and the 31

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- cooperation of state and local government in implementing such a system 1
- 2 is essential to the efficient operation of state and local government in
- 3 issuing operators' licenses and state identification cards.
- (2) It is therefor the intent of the Legislature that the Department 4
- 5 of Motor Vehicles shall use a portion of the fees appropriated by the
- 6 Legislature to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund as follows:
- 7 (a) To pay for the cost of issuing motor vehicle titles and
- 8 registrations on a system designated by the department. The costs shall
- 9 include, but not be limited to, software and software maintenance,
- programming, processing charges, and equipment including such terminals, 10
- 11 printers, or other devices as deemed necessary by the department after
- 12 consultation with the county to support the issuance of motor vehicle
- titles and registrations. The costs shall not include the cost of county 13
- 14 personnel or physical facilities provided by the counties;
- 15 (b) To fund the centralization of renewal notices for motor vehicle
- registration and to furnish to the counties the certificate 16
- 17 registration forms specified in section 60-390. The certificate of
- registration form shall be prescribed by the department; 18
- (c) To pay for the costs of an operator's license system as 19
- 20 specified in sections 60-484.01 and 60-4,119 and designated by the
- 21 department. The costs shall be limited to such terminals, printers,
- 22 software, programming, and other equipment or devices as deemed necessary
- 23 by the department to support the issuance of such licenses and state
- 24 identification cards in the counties and by the department; and
- (d) To pay for the motor vehicle insurance database created under 25
- 26 section 60-3,136.
- 27 (3) The department shall utilize three dollars of each fee allocated
- to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund from state identification 28
- 29 cards valid for five years and Class O or M operators' licenses valid for
- 30 five years to open and operate an additional operators' licensing service
- 31 center.
