Summary of purpose and/or changes:

A REVISED VERSION OF LB1266 WAS AMENDED INTO LB750. REFER TO THE LB750 COMMITTEE STATEMENT FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

Amends section 75-126; Regulation of common carriers by the Public Service Commission, prohibited acts.

This section prescribes a number actions or activities that regulated common carriers may not engage in as a matter of law.

Subsection (2) of the section sets forth a number exceptions where a common carrier will not be subject to a penalty for offering to an individual free or reduced rates.

The bill amends subsection (2) to provide that a regulated common carrier may offer free or reduced rates to any person who is 65 years of age or older.
