- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Business Innovation Act; to amend
- 2 sections 81-12,153 and 81-12,158, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 3 Supplement, 2020; to define a term; to change provisions relating to
- 4 a financial assistance program for creating prototypes; and to
- 5 repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 81-12,153, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 81-12,153 For purposes of the Business Innovation Act:
- 4 (1) Department means the Department of Economic Development;
- 5 (2) Economic redevelopment area means an area in the State of
- 6 <u>Nebraska in which:</u>
- 7 (a) The average rate of unemployment in the area during the period
- 8 covered by the most recent federal decennial census or American Community
- 9 Survey 5-Year Estimate by the United States Bureau of the Census is at
- 10 <u>least one hundred fifty percent of the average rate of unemployment in</u>
- 11 the state during the same period; and
- 12 <u>(b) The average poverty rate in the area is twenty percent or more</u>
- 13 for the federal census tract in the area;
- 14 (3) (2) Federal grant program means the federal Small Business
- 15 Administration's Small Business Innovation Research grant program or
- 16 Small Business Technology Transfer grant program;
- 17 (4) (3) Microenterprise means a for-profit business entity with not
- 18 more than ten full-time equivalent employees;
- 19 (5) (4) Prototype means an original model on which something is
- 20 patterned by a resident of Nebraska or a company located in Nebraska; and
- 21 (6) (5) Value-added agriculture means increasing the net worth of
- 22 food or nonfood agricultural products by processing, alternative
- 23 production and handling methods, collective marketing, or other
- 24 innovative practices.
- 25 Sec. 2. Section 81-12,158, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 26 2020, is amended to read:
- 27 81-12,158 (1) The department shall establish a financial assistance
- 28 program to provide financial assistance to businesses that employ no more
- 29 than five hundred employees or to individuals for the purposes of
- 30 creating a prototype of a product stemming from research and development
- 31 at a business operating in Nebraska or a public or private college or

- 1 university in Nebraska.
- 2 (2) Funds shall be matched by nonstate funds equivalent in money
- 3 equal to:
- 4 (a) Twenty-five percent of the funds requested if the applicant is
- 5 <u>located in an economic redevelopment area within a city of the</u>
- 6 <u>metropolitan class; or</u>
- 7 <u>(b) Fifty fifty percent of the funds requested for any other</u>
- 8 <u>applicant</u>.
- 9 (3) Matching funds may be from any nonstate source, including
- 10 private foundations, federal or local government sources, quasi-
- 11 governmental entities, or commercial lending institutions, or any other
- 12 funds whose source does not include funds appropriated by the
- 13 Legislature.
- 14 (4) The amount the department may provide shall not exceed one
- 15 hundred fifty thousand dollars per project.
- 16 (5) (3) A business or individual applying for financial assistance
- 17 under this section shall include a business plan that includes a proof-
- 18 of-concept demonstration.
- 19 (6) (4) Financial assistance under this section shall be expended
- 20 within twenty-four months after the date of the awarding decision.
- 21 (7) (5) The department may award up to <u>five</u> four million dollars per
- 22 year for financial assistance under this section.
