- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Interlocal Cooperation Act; to amend
- 2 section 13-809, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to
- 3 require approval by the voters for the issuance of certain bonds; to
- 4 repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 13-809, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 13-809 (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3) of this section, any
- 4 Any joint entity may from time to time issue its bonds in such principal
- 5 amounts as its governing body shall deem necessary to provide sufficient
- 6 funds to carry out any of the joint entity's purposes and powers,
- 7 including the establishment or increase of reserves, the payment of
- 8 interest accrued during construction of a project and for such period
- 9 thereafter as the governing body may determine, and the payment of all
- 10 other costs or expenses of the joint entity incident to and necessary or
- 11 convenient to carry out its purposes and powers.
- 12 (2) Bonds issued on or after April 18, 2018, for purposes of the
- 13 Public Facilities Construction and Finance Act shall be subject to a vote
- 14 prior to issuance as provided in the act.
- 15 (3)(a) For any joint entity created on or after the effective date
- 16 of this act that includes a Nebraska school district or educational
- 17 <u>service unit, such joint entity shall not issue any bonds until the</u>
- 18 question of issuing such bonds has been submitted to the qualified
- 19 electors of each Nebraska school district and educational service unit
- 20 that is part of the joint entity at an election called for that purpose
- 21 <u>as provided in this section and, within each such school district and</u>
- 22 <u>educational service unit, a majority of the qualified electors voting on</u>
- 23 the question voted in favor of issuing the bonds.
- 24 (b) Each such school district and educational service unit shall
- 25 give notice of the election at least fifty days prior to the election.
- 26 The question of issuing bonds may be submitted at the statewide primary
- 27 <u>or general election. The election shall be conducted in accordance with</u>
- 28 the Election Act.
- 29 <u>(c) The question of bond issues, when defeated, shall not be</u>
- 30 resubmitted in substance for a period of six months from and after the
- 31 date of such election.
