- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to the
- 2 Department of Administrative Services for incentive payments to
- 3 eligible school employees; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$XX,XXX,XXX from Federal
- 2 Funds for FY2021-22 to the Department of Administrative Services for
- 3 <u>incentive payments to eligible school employees at approved or accredited</u>
- 4 public, private, denominational, or parochial elementary and secondary
- 5 schools. The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the
- 6 funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus
- 7 State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan
- 8 Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 9 The budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 10 Administrative Services shall allocate one thousand dollars per eligible
- 11 school employee to each approved or accredited public, private,
- 12 <u>denominational</u>, or parochial elementary or secondary school which files
- 13 an application with the Department of Administrative Services on or
- 14 before May 15, 2022, that indicates the number of eligible school
- 15 <u>employees as of May 1, 2022, for which an allocation is requested. School</u>
- 16 employees eligible for the incentive payment include employees who
- 17 provide early childhood education but do not include administrators.
- 18 The Legislature finds that in order to respond to the ongoing
- 19 COVID-19 public health emergency, it is important to provide incentive
- 20 payments to ensure that public and private K-12 school personnel, along
- 21 with their affiliated early childhood education personnel, have adequate
- 22 and sufficient staffing. This includes teachers, para-educators, bus
- 23 drivers, food service handlers, librarians, and other support positions.
- Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 25 passed and approved according to law.
