- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Election Act; to amend section 32-1049,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 32-101, Revised
- 3 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to provide for secure ballot
- 4 drop-boxes as prescribed; to change requirements for using a vote
- 5 counting device; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
- 6 sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 32-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 32-101 Sections 32-101 to 32-1551 and section 2 of this act shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Election Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) If an election commissioner or county clerk maintains a
- 6 secure ballot drop-box for voters to deposit completed ballots, the
- 7 election commissioner or county clerk shall ensure that the secure ballot
- 8 <u>drop-box:</u>
- 9 (a) Is securely fastened to the ground or a concrete slab connected
- 10 to the ground;
- 11 (b) Is secured by a lock that can only be opened by the election
- 12 <u>commissioner or county clerk or by an election official designated by the</u>
- 13 <u>election commissioner or county clerk; and</u>
- 14 (c) Complies with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of
- 15 1990 and is accessible as determined by the election commissioner or
- 16 county clerk.
- 17 (2) The election commissioner or county clerk shall inform the
- 18 Secretary of State of each secure ballot drop-box's location no later
- 19 than forty-two days prior to any statewide primary or general election.
- 20 (3) The election commissioner or county clerk or an election
- 21 official designated by the election commissioner or county clerk shall
- 22 open each secure ballot drop-box no later than the sixth Friday prior to
- 23 any statewide primary or general election and no later than the fourth
- 24 Friday prior to any special election. Each secure ballot drop-box shall
- 25 remain accessible to voters until the deadline for the receipt of ballots
- 26 for any statewide primary or general election as provided in section
- 27 32-908 and for any special election as provided in section 32-954.
- 28 (4) After a secure ballot drop-box is made available for depositing
- 29 <u>ballots</u>, the election commission or county clerk shall ensure that
- 30 ballots deposited in such secure ballot drop-box are collected and
- 31 returned to the office of the election commissioner or county clerk at

- 1 least once during each business day.
- 2 <u>(5) The Secretary of State may adopt and promulgate rules and</u>
- 3 regulations to carry out this section.
- 4 Sec. 3. Section 32-1049, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 5 amended to read:
- 6 32-1049 Any election commissioner or county clerk using a vote
- 7 counting device to count ballots in a centralized location shall:
- 8 (1) Provide for the proper sealing of the containers and the
- 9 security of the ballots when transported from each polling place to the
- 10 centralized location and when removed from their containers and delivered
- 11 to the personnel who operate the vote counting devices;
- 12 (2) Provide a process of counting which allows for the ballots of
- 13 each precinct to be placed in a sealed container and placed in a secure
- 14 location after the counting process has been completed;
- 15 (3) Provide for a method of overseeing the ballots that have been
- 16 overvoted or damaged which does not involve judging voter intent to
- 17 assure that these ballots have not been or will not be intentionally
- 18 mismarked;
- 19 (4) Provide for a procedure for counting write-in votes when such
- 20 votes and names of write-in candidates are to be counted and recorded;
- 21 (5) Provide for at least three independent tests to be conducted
- 22 before counting begins to verify the accuracy of the counting process,
- 23 which includes the computerized program installed for counting various
- 24 ballots by vote counting devices, by (a) the election commissioner or
- 25 county clerk, (b) the chief deputy election commissioner or a registered
- 26 voter with a different party affiliation than that of the election
- 27 commissioner or county clerk, and (c) the person who installed the
- 28 program in the vote counting device or the person in charge of operating
- 29 the device;
- 30 (6) Provide for storing and safeguarding the magnetic tapes or
- 31 computer chips of the vote counting devices for the required period of

- 1 time;
- 2 (7) Provide the appropriate security personnel or measures necessary
- 3 to safeguard the secrecy and security of the counting process;
- 4 (8) Develop a procedure for picking up and counting ballots during
- 5 election day at the discretion of the election commissioner or county
- 6 clerk. No report or tabulation of vote totals for such ballots shall be
- 7 produced or generated prior to one hour before the closing of the polls;
- 8 and
- 9 (9) Develop a procedure for picking up and transporting ballots from
- 10 a secure ballot drop-box to the office of the election commissioner or
- 11 <u>county clerk; and</u>
- 12 (10) (9) Submit a written plan to the Secretary of State
- 13 specifically outlining the procedures that will be followed on election
- 14 day to implement this section. The plan shall be submitted no later than
- 15 twenty-five days before the election and shall be modified, as necessary,
- 16 for each primary, general, or special election.
- 17 Sec. 4. Original section 32-1049, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 18 Nebraska, and section 32-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 19 2020, are repealed.
