## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 696**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds to the State Department of Education; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:
- 2 (a) Since the onset of the COVID-19 public health emergency,
- 3 Nebraska public elementary and secondary schools have had difficulty
- 4 filling open and necessary job positions. Such job positions include
- 5 teachers, paraeducators, bus drivers, food service handlers, librarians,
- 6 and other support staff; and
- 7 <u>(b) It is necessary to provide retention payments to public</u>
- 8 <u>elementary and secondary school employees in order to decrease the number</u>
- 9 of open job positions created by the COVID-19 public health emergency.
- 10 (2) There is hereby appropriated \$XXXX from Federal Funds for
- 11 FY2022-23 to the State Department of Education for the purposes of school
- 12 <u>employee retention. The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are</u>
- 13 from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal
- 14 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American
- 15 Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 16 (3)(a) The State Department of Education shall administer a program
- 17 to provide grants to all school districts for purposes of school employee
- 18 retention.
- 19 (b) The amount of the grant provided to each school district shall
- 20 be a proportionate share of the total amount appropriated under
- 21 subsection (2) of this section. Each school district's share shall be
- 22 based on the percentage of the Nebraska population residing in such
- 23 school district according to the most recent federal decennial census or
- 24 the most recent revised certified count by the United States Bureau of
- 25 the Census.
- 26 <u>(c) A school district receiving such grant shall divide the grant</u>
- 27 <u>evenly among all eligible school employees at the time of receiving the</u>
- 28 grant.
- 29 <u>(d) The State Department of Education shall administer and</u>
- 30 coordinate the distribution of grants pursuant to this section in
- 31 compliance with the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

1 (e) For purposes of this section, eligible school employee means an

- 2 <u>individual employed by a school. Eligible school employee does not</u>
- 3 <u>include any school administrator.</u>
- 4 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 5 passed and approved according to law.
