1 Section 1. Section 38-3205, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

2 amended to read:

3 38-3205 Respiratory care means the health specialty responsible for 4 the treatment, management, diagnostic testing, control, and care of 5 patients with deficiencies and abnormalities associated with the cardiopulmonary system. Respiratory care is shall not be limited to a 6 7 hospital setting and includes shall include the therapeutic and diagnostic management and maintenance use of medical gases, administering 8 9 apparatus, humidification and aerosols, ventilatory management assistance and ventilatory control, postural drainage, chest physiotherapy and 10 exercises, respiratory rehabilitation, cardiopulmonary 11 breathing resuscitation and rehabilitation, and maintenance and insertion of lines, 12 13 drains, and artificial and nonartificial airways without cutting tissues of nasal or oral endotracheal tubes. Respiratory care shall also includes 14 15 include the administration of all pharmacologic, diagnostic, and therapeutic agents for the treatment and diagnosis of cardiopulmonary 16 disease for which the respiratory care practitioner has been 17 professionally trained or has obtained advance education or 18 certification, including specific testing techniques employed in 19 respiratory care to assist in diagnosis, monitoring, treatment, and 20 research of how specific cardiopulmonary disease affects the patient 21 22 aerosol and inhalant medications to the cardiorespiratory system and specific testing techniques employed in respiratory care to assist in 23 24 diagnosis, monitoring, treatment, and research. Such techniques shall 25 include management , but not be limited to, measurement of ventilatory volumes, pressures, and flows, measurement of physiologic partial 26 27 pressures, pulmonary function testing, and hemodynamic <u>insertion of</u> 28 <u>lines</u>, and other related physiological monitoring of the cardiopulmonary 29 system.
