- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to adopt the Precision
- 2 Agriculture Infrastructure Grant Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 6 of this act shall be known and may be

- 2 <u>cited as the Precision Agriculture Infrastructure Grant Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the Precision Agriculture Infrastructure
- 4 Grant Act:
- 5 (1) Adequate broadband speed means a symmetrical download and upload
- 6 speed of at least fifty megabits per second;
- 7 (2) Department means the Department of Economic Development;
- 8 (3) Program means the Precision Agriculture Infrastructure Grant
- 9 Program created in section 3 of this act; and
- 10 (4) Provider means a broadband Internet service provider, including
- 11 <u>any telecommunications company or wireless network provider that provides</u>
- 12 <u>broadband Internet service.</u>
- 13 Sec. 3. (1) The Precision Agriculture Infrastructure Grant Program
- 14 <u>is created. The department shall administer the program. The purposes of</u>
- 15 the program are to:
- 16 <u>(a) Propel Nebraska agricultural producers to lead the nation in</u>
- 17 precision agriculture connectivity, sustainability, traceability, and
- 18 <u>autonomy to accelerate rural economic development; and</u>
- 19 <u>(b) Provide high-speed Internet service to the most remote and cost-</u>
- 20 prohibitive areas of the state.
- 21 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate ten million
- 22 dollars from Federal Funds for fiscal year 2022-23 to the department to
- 23 carry out the program. The Federal Funds to be appropriated are from
- 24 funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus
- 25 State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan
- 26 Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 27 Sec. 4. <u>(1) A provider, an agricultural cooperative, an agronomist,</u>
- 28 or an agricultural producer may apply to the department for a grant under
- 29 the program. The application shall be made on forms prescribed by the
- 30 <u>department</u>.
- 31 (2) Grants may only be used to provide:

- 1 (a) Symmetrical broadband service to on-farm structures and devices,
- 2 including, but not limited to, tractors, combines, irrigation systems,
- 3 livestock facilities, and farm offices. The broadband service shall be at
- 4 <u>an adequate broadband speed;</u>
- 5 (b) On-farm traceability solutions that satisfy food supply
- 6 stakeholder demand, including blockchain;
- 7 (c) Products that improve soil health, water management tools and
- 8 <u>sensors that facilitate judicious use of water resources, and products</u>
- 9 that promote the use of water efficiency seed technologies that lower
- 10 <u>agriculture's water, carbon, and nitrate footprint; and</u>
- 11 (d) Products that use autonomous solutions in agricultural
- 12 <u>machinery, including, but not limited to, grain carts, spreaders,</u>
- 13 precision drone scouting, and scouting robots.
- 14 (3) The department shall award up to one-half of the available grant
- 15 funds for the purpose described in subdivision (2)(a) of this section and
- 16 <u>up to one-half of the available grant funds for the purposes described in</u>
- 17 <u>subdivisions (2)(b), (c), and (d) of this section.</u>
- 18 Sec. 5. <u>If the grant application is to provide symmetrical</u>
- 19 broadband service as described in subdivision (2)(a) of section 4 of this
- 20 <u>act, the applicant shall agree to:</u>
- 21 (1) Complete the project within twelve months after the date on
- 22 which the grant is awarded. The department may permit one extension of up
- 23 to six months upon request and for good cause shown; and
- 24 (2) Submit the broadband service to speed tests. If the speed tests
- 25 show that the broadband service is not providing adequate broadband
- 26 <u>speed, the applicant shall be allowed a reasonable time to correct the</u>
- 27 <u>deficiencies.</u>
- 28 Sec. 6. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 29 <u>regulations to carry out the Precision Agriculture Infrastructure Grant</u>
- 30 Act.
