- 3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 <u>and section 2 of this act</u>
- 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability
- 5 and Disclosure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) This section applies to any election for the following
- 7 elective offices: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State,
- 8 State Treasurer, Attorney General, Auditor of Public Accounts, member of
- 9 the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, member of the State
- 10 <u>Board of Education, Public Service Commissioner, and member of the</u>
- 11 <u>Legislature</u>.
- 12 <u>(2) For purposes of this section, campaign advertisement means a</u>
- 13 professionally produced visual or audio recording disseminated or caused
- 14 to be disseminated (a) by a candidate for any elective office listed in
- 15 this section or by any committee and (b) for the purpose of supporting or
- opposing the nomination or election of such a candidate.
- 17 (3) No campaign advertisement shall be disseminated:
- 18 <u>(a) On television or as a video by means of the Internet unless the</u>
- 19 campaign advertisement includes closed captioning or the candidate or
- 20 committee responsible for the campaign advertisement posts a transcript
- 21 of such campaign advertisement on the candidate's or committee's website;
- 22 <u>or</u>
- 23 (b) On radio unless the candidate or committee responsible for the
- 24 campaign advertisement posts a transcript of such campaign advertisement
- on the candidate's or committee's website.
