3 Sec. 2. (1) In order to educate students about the dangers posed by
4 the drug fentanyl and the risks of fentanyl poisoning, including
5 overdose, the Governor shall designate a week during the normal school
6 year to be known as Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week in public schools.

7 (2) Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week may include age-appropriate
8 instruction, including instruction on the prevention of the abuse of and
9 addiction to fentanyl, as determined by each school district.

10 Sec. 3. Beginning with school year 2025-26, each school district
11 shall annually provide research-based instruction related to fentanyl
12 abuse prevention and drug poisoning awareness to students in grades six
13 through twelve. The instruction required by this section must include
14 instruction concerning:

15 (1) Suicide prevention;

16 (2) Prevention of the abuse of and addiction to fentanyl;

17 (3) Awareness of local school and community resources and any
18 processes involved in accessing those resources;

19 (4) Methods of administering an opioid antagonist; and

20 (5) Health education that includes information about substance use
21 and abuse, including youth substance use and abuse.
