special designated license under this section for more than six calendar 22

days in any one calendar year, except that a nonprofit corporation, the

has been exempted from the payment of federal income taxes, may be issued

a special designated license for up to twelve calendar days in any one 26

2 (b) A municipal corporation, a fine arts museum incorporated as a 3 nonprofit corporation, a religious nonprofit corporation which has been exempted from the payment of federal income 4 taxes, 5 organization which has been exempted from the payment of federal income 6 taxes, or any other nonprofit corporation, the purpose of which is 7 fraternal, charitable, or public service and which has been exempted from 8 the payment of federal income taxes, may apply for special designated 9 licenses for the same location in a single application. The application shall include all dates and times for which a special designated license 10 11 is being requested at such location.

- 12 (c) This subsection shall not apply to any holder of a catering license. 13
- 14 (3) Except for any special designated license issued to a holder of 15 a catering license or to an organization or corporation as provided in subdivision (2)(b) of this section, there shall be a fee of forty dollars 16 17 for each day identified in the special designated license. For a special designated license issued to an organization or corporation as provided 18 in subdivision (2)(b) of this section, there shall be a fee of forty 19 20 dollars for the initial special designated license and ten dollars for 21 each additional day beyond the first at the same location in such 22 application. Such fee shall be submitted with the application for the 23 special designated license, collected by the commission, and remitted to 24 the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund. The applicant shall be exempt from the provisions of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act 25 26 requiring an application or renewal fee and the provisions of the act 27 requiring the expiration of forty-five days from the time the application is received by the commission prior to the issuance of a license, if 28 29 granted by the commission. (4) No special designated license provided for by this section shall be issued by the commission without the approval of the local governing body. The local governing body may establish criteria for approving or denying a special designated license. The local governing body may designate an agent to determine whether a special designated license is to be approved or denied. Such agent shall follow criteria established by the local governing body in making his or her determination. The determination of the agent shall be considered the determination of the local governing body unless otherwise provided by the local governing body. For purposes of this section, the local governing body shall be the city or village within which the premises for which the special designated license is requested are located or, if such premises are not within the corporate limits of a city or village, then the local

designated license is requested, and (f) sufficient evidence that the

activity will be supervised by persons or managers who are agents of and

directly responsible to the holder of the special designated license.
