Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill is the annual omnibus elections cleanup and update bill. It includes suggested revisions to the Election Act, including: procedures for voter registration removal; poll worker compensation; release of digital images; lists of registered voters; candidates for special elections; presidential elector meeting locations and dates; certificate of ascertainment security features; precinct list notations; reasonable impediment certifications; verification of driver's



licenses or state identification cards; early voting in special elections; notification of officials; remittance schedules; and state identification cards.
