Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 357 increases the maximum support allowable under the Disabled Persons and Family Support Act from \$300 per month to \$600, for disabled persons.

Sec. 1: The maximum support allowable shall be \$600 per month per disabled person averaged over any one-year period or \$600 per month per family averaged over any one-year period for the first disabled family member plus \$300 per month averaged over any one-year for each additional disabled family member.

It is the intent of the Legislature that any appropriation relating to this section be increased accordingly so that each person who received support prior to the effective date of this act will continue to receive support.
