- 9 (iii) all independent boards, commissions, bureaus, committees, councils,

- statute, or otherwise pursuant to law, (iv) all study or advisory 11
- committees of the executive department of the State of Nebraska whether 12
- 13 having continuing existence or appointed as special committees with
- limited existence, (v) advisory committees of the bodies referred to in 14
- subdivisions (i), (ii), and (iii) of this subdivision, and (vi) 15
- instrumentalities exercising essentially public functions, and (vii) 16
- 17 entities, whether private, public, or quasi-governmental, which may by
- law exercise the power of eminent domain; and 18
- 19 (b) Public body does not include (i) subcommittees of such bodies
- unless a quorum of the public body attends a subcommittee meeting or 20
- unless such subcommittees are holding hearings, making policy, or taking 21
- 22 formal action on behalf of their parent body, except that all meetings of
- any subcommittee established under section 81-15,175 are subject to the 23
- 24 Open Meetings Act, (ii) entities conducting judicial proceedings unless a
- 25 court or other judicial body is exercising rulemaking authority,
- deliberating, or deciding upon the issuance of administrative orders, and 26
- (iii) the Judicial Resources Commission or subcommittees or subgroups of 27

- (2) Meeting means all regular, special, or called meetings, formal 29
- or informal, of any public body for the purposes of briefing, discussion 30
- of public business, formation of tentative policy, or the taking of any 31
