- 2 amend sections 23-2332 and 23-2332.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska; to change contribution rates relating to supplemental
- 4 retirement plans for certain law enforcement personnel; and to
- 5 repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 23-2332, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

2 amended to read:

3 23-2332 Any county with a population in excess of eighty-five thousand inhabitants that which participates in the Retirement System for 4 5 Nebraska Counties established by the County Employees Retirement Act shall establish and fund a supplemental retirement plan for the benefit 6 of all present and future commissioned law enforcement personnel employed 7 by such county. The auxiliary benefit plan shall be funded by additional 8 9 contributions to the county employees retirement plan in excess of the amounts established by sections 23-2307 and 23-2308. The additional 10 contributions made by employees shall be credited to the employee 11 account, and contributions paid by the county shall be credited to the 12 employer account, with each amount to be established at a rate of three 13 two percent of compensation. All contributions made pursuant to this 14 section shall be invested and administered according to the County 15 Employees Retirement Act. 16

Sec. 2. Section 23-2332.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

23-2332.01 Any county with a population of eighty-five thousand 19 inhabitants or less that which participates in the Retirement System for 20 Nebraska Counties established by the County Employees Retirement Act 21 22 shall establish and fund a supplemental retirement plan for the benefit of all present and future commissioned law enforcement personnel employed 23 24 by such county who possess a valid law enforcement officer certificate or 25 diploma, as established by the Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council. The auxiliary benefit plan shall be funded by additional 26 contributions to the county employees retirement plan in excess of the 27 amounts established by sections 23-2307 and 23-2308. The additional 28 contributions made by employees shall be credited to the employee 29 account, and contributions paid by the county shall be credited to the 30 31 employer account, with each amount to be established at a rate of two one LB160 2023 LB160 2023

- 1 percent of compensation. All contributions made pursuant to this section
