- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend sections 77-3446 and
- 2 79-1015.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to
- 3 prohibit changes to the base limitation and the local effort rate
- 4 calculation as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 77-3446, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2022, is amended to read:
- 3 77-3446 (1) Base limitation means the budget limitation rate
- 4 applicable to school districts and the limitation on growth of restricted
- 5 funds applicable to other political subdivisions prior to any increases
- 6 in the rate as a result of special actions taken by a supermajority of
- 7 any governing board or of any exception allowed by law.
- 8 (2) The base limitation for political subdivisions other than school
- 9 <u>districts</u> is two and one-half percent until adjusted, except that the
- 10 base limitation for school districts for school fiscal years 2017-18 and
- 11 2018-19 is one and one-half percent and for school fiscal year 2019-20 is
- 12 two percent. Such percentage The base limitation may be adjusted annually
- 13 by the Legislature to reflect changes in the prices of services and
- 14 products used by <u>such</u> school districts and political subdivisions.
- 15 (3) The base limitation for school districts is two and one-half
- 16 percent. Such percentage shall not be adjusted by the Legislature on or
- 17 after the effective date of this act.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 79-1015.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 19 2022, is amended to read:
- 20 79-1015.01 (1) Local system formula resources shall include local
- 21 effort rate yield which shall be computed as prescribed in this section.
- 22 (2) For each school fiscal year—except school fiscal years 2017-18
- 23 and 2018-19: (a) For state aid certified pursuant to section 79-1022, the
- 24 local effort rate shall be the maximum levy, for the school fiscal year
- 25 for which aid is being certified, authorized pursuant to subdivision (2)
- 26 (a) of section 77-3442 less five cents; (b) for the final calculation of
- 27 state aid pursuant to section 79-1065, the local effort rate shall be the
- 28 rate which, when multiplied by the total adjusted valuation of all
- 29 taxable property in local systems receiving equalization aid pursuant to
- 30 the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act, will produce
- 31 the amount needed to support the total formula need of such local systems

- 1 when added to state aid appropriated by the Legislature and other actual
- 2 receipts of local systems described in section 79-1018.01; and (c) the
- 3 local effort rate yield for such school fiscal years shall be determined
- 4 by multiplying each local system's total adjusted valuation by the local
- 5 effort rate. The Legislature shall not make any changes to the way the
- 6 <u>local effort rate is calculated under this section on or after the</u>
- 7 effective date of this act.
- 8 (3) For school fiscal years 2017-18 and 2018-19: (a) For state aid
- 9 certified pursuant to section 79-1022, the local effort rate shall be the
- 10 maximum levy, for the school fiscal year for which aid is being
- 11 certified, authorized pursuant to subdivision (2)(a) of section 77-3442
- 12 less two and ninety-seven hundredths cents; (b) for the final calculation
- 13 of state aid pursuant to section 79-1065, the local effort rate shall be
- 14 the rate which, when multiplied by the total adjusted valuation of all
- 15 taxable property in local systems receiving equalization aid pursuant to
- 16 the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act, will produce
- 17 the amount needed to support the total formula need of such local systems
- 18 when added to state aid appropriated by the Legislature and other actual
- 19 receipts of local systems described in section 79-1018.01; and (c) the
- 20 local effort rate yield for such school fiscal years shall be determined
- 21 by multiplying each local system's total adjusted valuation by the local
- 22 effort rate.
