- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court; to amend sections 48-163, 48-164, 48-174, and 49-506, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act relating to notice for rules and regulations, case progression requirements, and summonses; to change
- 7 legislative journals; and to repeal the original sections.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 48-163, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 48-163 (1) The Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, by a majority
- 4 vote of the judges thereof, may adopt and promulgate all reasonable rules
- 5 and regulations necessary for carrying out the intent and purpose of the
- 6 Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act, except that rules and regulations
- 7 relating to the compensation court's adjudicatory function shall become
- 8 effective only upon approval of the Supreme Court.
- 9 (2) No rule or regulation to carry out the act shall be adopted and
- 10 promulgated except after public hearing conducted by a quorum of the
- 11 compensation court on the question of adopting and promulgating such rule
- 12 or regulation. Notice of such hearing shall be given at least <u>fourteen</u>
- 13 thirty days prior thereto by publication in a newspaper having general
- 14 circulation in the state. Draft copies of all such rules and regulations
- 15 shall be available to the public at the compensation court at the time of
- 16 giving notice.
- 17 (3) The administrator of the compensation court shall establish and
- 18 maintain a list of subscribers who wish to receive notice of public
- 19 hearing on the question of adopting and promulgating any rule or
- 20 regulation and shall provide notice to such subscribers. The
- 21 administrator shall distribute a current copy of existing rules and
- 22 regulations and any updates to those rules and regulations once adopted
- 23 to the State Library and to each county law library or the largest public
- 24 library in each county.
- 25 Sec. 2. Section 48-164, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 26 amended to read:
- 27 48-164 The Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court shall regulate and
- 28 provide the kind and character of notices and the services thereof and,
- 29 in case of an injury by accident to an employee, the nature and extent of
- 30 the proofs and evidence and the method of taking and furnishing the same
- 31 for the establishment of the right to compensation. It shall determine

- 1 the nature and form or forms of the application of those claiming to be
- 2 entitled to benefits or compensation and shall regulate the method of
- 3 making investigations, physical examinations, and inspections and
- 4 prescribe the time within which adjudications and awards shall be made_T
- 5 except that when a petition for compensation is filed, a hearing shall be
- 6 held within sixty days from the date of the filing thereof and an order
- 7 or award made and entered thereon within thirty days after such hearing.
- 8 Such rules and regulations shall conform to the provisions of the
- 9 Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act.
- 10 Sec. 3. Section 48-174, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 48-174 Upon the filing of such petition a summons shall issue and be
- 13 served upon the adverse party, as in civil causes, together with a copy
- 14 of the petition. Return of service shall be made within <u>fourteen</u> seven
- 15 days after the date of issue. An acknowledgment on the summons or the
- 16 voluntary appearance of a defendant is equivalent to service.
- 17 Sec. 4. Section 49-506, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 49-506 After the Secretary of State has made the distribution
- 20 provided by section 49-503, he or she shall deliver additional copies of
- 21 the session laws and the journal of the Legislature pursuant to this
- 22 section in print or electronic format as he or she determines, upon
- 23 recommendation by the Clerk of the Legislature and approval of the
- 24 Executive Board of the Legislative Council.
- 25 One copy of the session laws shall be delivered to the Lieutenant
- 26 Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the
- 27 Reporter of the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals, the State Court
- 28 Administrator, the State Fire Marshal, the Department of Administrative
- 29 Services, the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Banking and
- 30 Finance, the State Department of Education, the Department of Environment
- 31 and Energy, the Department of Insurance, the Department of Labor, the

Department of Motor Vehicles, the Department of Revenue, the Department 2 of Transportation, the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the Department of Natural Resources, the Military Department, the Nebraska State Patrol, 3 4 the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice, each of 5 the Nebraska state colleges, the Game and Parks Commission, the Nebraska Library Commission, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the Nebraska 6 7 Accountability and Disclosure Commission, the Public Service Commission, the State Real Estate Commission, the Nebraska State Historical Society, 8 9 the Public Employees Retirement Board, the Risk Manager, the Legislative 10 Fiscal Analyst, the Public Counsel, the materiel division of the Department of Administrative Services, the State Records Administrator, 11 the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services, the Tax 12 13 Equalization and Review Commission, the inmate library at all state penal and correctional institutions, the Commission on Public Advocacy, and the 14 15 Library of Congress; two copies to the Governor, the Secretary of State, the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, the Commission of Industrial 16 17 Relations, and the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education, one of which shall be for use by the community colleges; three copies to 18 19 the Department of Health and Human Services; four copies to the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; five copies to the Attorney General; nine 20 copies to the Revisor of Statutes; sixteen copies to the Supreme Court 21 22 and the Legislative Council; and thirty-five copies to the University of Nebraska College of Law. 23 24 One copy of the journal of the Legislature shall be delivered to the 25 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the Reporter of the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals, 26 the State Court Administrator, the Nebraska State Historical Society, the 27 Legislative Fiscal Analyst, the Tax Equalization and Review Commission, 28 the Commission on Public Advocacy, and the Library of Congress; two 29 copies to the Secretary of State $_{T}$ and the Commission of Industrial 30 Relations; , and the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court; four copies to 31

- 1 the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; five copies to the Attorney
- 2 General and the Revisor of Statutes; eight copies to the Clerk of the
- 3 Legislature; thirteen copies to the Supreme Court and the Legislative
- 4 Council; and thirty-five copies to the University of Nebraska College of
- 5 Law. The remaining copies shall be delivered to the State Librarian who
- 6 shall use the same, so far as required for exchange purposes, in building
- 7 up the State Library and in the manner specified in sections 49-507 to
- 8 49-509.
