1 Section 1. Section 33-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 33-156 (1) In addition to all other court costs assessed according
- 4 to law, an indigent defense fee of eight three dollars shall be taxed as
- 5 costs for each case filed in each county court and district court,
- 6 including appeals to such courts, and for each appeal and original action
- 7 filed in the Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court. The fees shall be
- 8 remitted to the State Treasurer on forms prescribed by the State
- 9 Treasurer within ten days after the end of the month. The State Treasurer
- 10 shall credit the fees to the Commission on Public Advocacy Operations
- 11 Cash Fund.
- 12 (2) In cases under the DNA Testing Act, costs shall be paid as
- 13 provided in such act.
- 14 Sec. 2. Original section 33-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 15 Nebraska, is repealed.
