The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB136 is proposed legislation that amends, revises, and harmonizes certain laws relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles. The bill allows for ATV and UTV owners to file application for title with the county treasurer of any county. The bill allows owners to obtain title to a vehicle with a United States Government Certificate to Obtain Title without an identification inspection and allows individuals to check the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System or the Nebraska Crime Information Service when conducting an identification inspection of a vehicle. The bill changes a term to allow for all brands on out of state certificates of title to be carried forward to Nebraska certificates of title. The bill allows the Director to suspend, revoke, cancel, or refuse to issue or renew registrations for an applicant who has committed a violation of the International Registration Act. The bill outlines provisions beginning January 1, 2024 increasing the seasonal period of validity of restricted commercial operator's licenses from 180 to 210 days. The bill also harmonizes and removes various obsolete statutory language.
