The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The intent of LB516 is to increase school safety in the State of Nebraska and better support student's mental health. LB516 does the following:

- The Department of Education will hire regional specialists to assist schools and increase the availability of training, provide tailored technical support and serve as a center point of contact for school districts.
- After federal funding for the Safe2HelpNE hotline ends in fiscal year 2023-24, general funds will begin funding the program.
- Create a grant program that schools may apply to for critical infrastructure needs like surveillance equipment, door-locking systems and double-entry doors.
- Create a grant program to provide funding to local health departments or educational service units to hire mental health practitioners and school psychologists to provide services to students and the community.
