Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB65

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB65 would change the Department of Health and Human Services' licensure reporting system to differentiate between self-reported violations, and complaint-related licensing violations in its database, and all public reporting created by the complaint tracking system.

Additionally, in the event that a licensing violation leads to the Department of Health and Human Services taking disciplinary action against a child care facility, LB65 would require the Department to provide notice by mail to all parents and guardians of children attending a child care. LB65 would not require notification in instances of a licensing violation where disciplinary action is not taken.
