

LEGISLATIVE BILL 495

Approved by the Governor April 14, 1971

Introduced by Harold T. Moylan, 6th District

AN ACT to amend section 25-2154, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to foreclosure of mortgages; to increase the fee for the certificate of satisfaction to be paid to the clerk of the district court as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 25-2154, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

25-2154. In all cases of foreclosure of mortgages in the several counties in the state, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the district court, on the satisfaction or payment of the amount of the decree, to forward to the register of deeds a certificate setting forth the names of parties, plaintiff and defendant, descriptions of the premises mentioned in the decree, and the book and page where the mortgage foreclosed is recorded, for which certificate such clerk shall collect a fee of ~~one-dollar~~ three dollars, which amount shall be taxed as part of the costs in the case, and said sum shall be paid to the register of deeds as his fee for recording the certificate.

Sec. 2. That original section 25-2154, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
