

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 513

Approved by the Governor April 28, 1971

Introduced by Irving F. Wiltse, 1st District; E. Thome Johnson, 15th District

AN ACT to amend section 72-222, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to public lands and buildings; to provide that rural water districts may acquire land or interests in educational land held by the state; to broaden the power of other subdivisions; and to repeal the original section.  
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 72-222, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

72-222. Any irrigation district, rural water district, public power district or public power and irrigation district, watershed conservancy district or watershed district may acquire from the state any educational land, or portion thereof, or interest therein for the purpose for which such districts are authorized by law to condemn private lands in this state. In addition, a watershed conservancy district or a watershed district may acquire an easement or right-of-way for the purpose of constructing, replacing, operating, and maintaining structures which are a part of the program of work of the district.

Sec. 2. That original section 72-222, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
