

LEGISLATIVE BILL 477

Approved by the Governor May 2, 1973

Introduced by Schmit, 23, for the Governor

AN ACT relating to paupers and public assistance; to provide for state financial participation in county emergency assistance benefits on behalf of families who have children; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. From such funds as may be appropriated for such purpose, the Department of Public Welfare shall match expenditures of county funds for emergency assistance benefits on behalf of families who have children, under sections 68-103 to 68-116, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and amendments thereto. In addition, the Department of Public Welfare shall allocate to counties for such emergency assistance purposes all funds which may be made available for such purpose by the government of the United States.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
