AN ACT to amend section 31-1401, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, 1943, relating to law
enforcement; to redefine a term; and to repeal
the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 31-1401, Reissue Revised
Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as
follows:

31-1401. As used in sections 31-1401 to 31-1414,
unless the context otherwise requires:

(1) Commission shall mean the Nebraska Commission
on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice;

(2) Council shall mean the Nebraska Police
Standards Advisory Council;

(3) (a) Law enforcement officer shall mean any
person who is responsible for the prevention or detection
of crime or the enforcement of the penal, traffic, or
highway laws of the state or any political subdivision
thereof on-a-regular-basis for more than one hundred
hours per year and is authorized by law to make arrests,
and includes but is not limited to:

(a) (i) A full or part-time member of the
Nebraska State Patrol;

(b) (ii) A county sheriff;

(c) (iii) A full or part-time employee of a
county sheriff's office; or

(d) (iv) A full or part-time employee of a
municipal or village police agency; but

(b) Law enforcement officer shall not include
employees of the Department of Correctional Services,
probation officers under the Field Probation Service or
appointed under section 43-236, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, 1943, or parole officers appointed by the
Parole Administrator;

(4) Director shall mean the director of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center; and

(5) Training center shall mean the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center.

Sec. 2. That original section 81-1401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
