

LEGISLATIVE BILL 149

Approved by the Governor March 2, 1983

Introduced by Lamb, 43

AN ACT to amend section 54-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to livestock; to exempt livestock owners from liability as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 54-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

54-401. The owners of cattle, horses, mules, swine, and sheep in this state, shall hereafter be liable for all damages done by such stock upon the cultivated lands in this state as provided by section 54-402 if the damages to the cultivated lands are not the result of negligent or willful damage to the division fence by the person claiming damages to the cultivated lands.

Sec. 2. That original section 54-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
