AN ACT relating to game and parks; to amend section 37-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change the information required on a permit; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 37-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

37-202. Permits to hunt, fish, or harvest fur shall be issued on a form prepared and supplied by the Game and Parks Commission. Such permit shall bear a description of the person to whom issued, setting forth ~~occupation~~, age, color of eyes and hair, height and weight, and the date of its issuance. All permits shall bear the signature of the secretary of the commission or a facsimile of such signature. All legally issued permits shall authorize the person named therein to hunt for, kill, or take game and fish or to harvest furbearers, in lawful season and manner, during the period for which the permit is issued. All of ~~such said~~ permits, except for those permits for veterans provided by section 37-214.03 and for persons at least seventy years old provided by section 37-214.04 which shall be permanent permits, shall expire at midnight on December 31 of the year in which issued. ~~Trapping and fur buyer permits which were purchased prior to January 17, 1982, and expire on June 30, 1982, are hereby made valid through June 30, 1982, at no additional fee.~~ To be valid a permit must be countersigned by the holder. The permit shall be on the person of the holder, at all times while he or she is hunting, fur harvesting, or fishing, and shall be shown immediately upon demand to any officer or person whose duty it is to enforce the provisions of this act. Any person hunting, fishing, or fur harvesting in this state without such permit actually on or about his or her person, as above required, shall be deemed to be without such permit.

Sec. 2. This act shall become operative on January 1, 1986.

Sec. 3. That original section 37-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
