AN ACT relating to cities; to provide for intervention by
owners of adjoining property in certain cases.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. In cases of appeal from an action of
the city council condemning real property as a nuisance or
as dangerous under the police powers of the city, the
owners of the adjoining property may intervene in the
action at any time before trial.
