

LEGISLATIVE BILL 199

AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-2504, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to representation on a commission as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-2504, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-2504. The provisions of Article III, SECTION A., of the Compact for Education notwithstanding, the members of the Education Commission of the states representing this state shall consist of the Governor, ~~four~~ three members of the Legislature selected by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council, and ~~two~~ three members appointed by the Governor. Of the three members appointed by the Governor, one member shall be a member of a school board or board of education of a Class II, III, IV, V, or VI school district or an appointed representative of a state association of school boards or boards of education representing such districts.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-2504, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
