

LEGISLATIVE BILL 22

Approved by the Governor February 2, 1987

Introduced by Marsh, 29, Vice-Chairperson, Exec. Board

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-335, 60-335.01, and 60-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to correct references to repealed statutes; to harmonize provisions; to transfer a section; to delete obsolete provisions; and to repeal the original sections, and also sections 60-335.02 and 81-1012, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-335, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-335. No registration fee shall be charged for any motor vehicle owned by any city or village of this state used in connection with police, street, public transportation, park, library, or fire prevention activities, fire trucks owned and used by any rural fire protection district, a motor vehicle owned and operated by the Civil Air Patrol, ~~nor for~~ any motor vehicle owned and used by any public school district, county, state, or United States government, ~~nor or~~ any motor vehicles of any municipal public body or authority used in operating a public passenger transportation system. Any motor vehicle owned by this state or any political subdivision as set forth in this section, and exempt from a distinct marking as provided in section 60-1001, may carry number plates the same design and size as provided in subsection (3) of section 60-1003 60-311.

Sec. 2. That section 60-335.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

~~60-335-01.~~ The term use in a governmental capacity as used in section 77-2704 shall include the operation of a municipally owned public transportation system for passengers.

Sec. 3. That section 60-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-1004. Any employee or officer of the State of Nebraska who operates or has under his or her control

any state-owned motor vehicle or unit of road machinery, not numbered, lettered, or marked as required by section 60-1001, or who violates any of the other provisions of sections 60-1001 and 60-1001.01 and subsection (3) of section 60-311 to 60-1003 shall be deemed guilty of official misconduct in office for a palpable omission of duty, and upon conviction thereof shall be guilty of a Class II misdemeanor, and the court shall have the power to add to the judgment that any officer so convicted shall be removed from office or employment.

Sec. 4. That original sections 60-335, 60-335.01, and 60-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also sections 60-335.02 and 81-1012, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
