

LEGISLATIVE BILL 834

Passed over the Governor's veto April 9, 1990.

Introduced by Haberman, 44

AN ACT relating to retirement; to amend section 84-1307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change the age for voluntary membership in the State Employees Retirement System; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 84-1307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

84-1307. The membership of the retirement system shall be composed of (1) all permanent full-time employees who have been employees for a period of twenty-four continuous months at any time and who have attained the age of thirty and (2) all full-time or part-time employees who have been employees for a total of twelve months, who have attained the age of ~~twenty-five~~ twenty, and who exercise the option to join the retirement system. An employee who exercises the option to join the retirement system pursuant to this section shall remain in the retirement system until his or her termination or retirement. Membership shall not include part-time or temporary employees, except (a) such part-time employees who have been full-time employees but because of age or otherwise have been partially incapacitated and have been placed on a part-time service basis at a part-time rate of pay under rules and regulations of the retirement board, (b) such part-time employees who are members of the system, and (c) part-time employees who join the system as provided in subdivision (2) of this section.

Sec. 2. That original section 84-1307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
