

LEGISLATIVE BILL 199

Approved by the Governor April 10, 1991

Introduced by Lynch, 13

AN ACT relating to commemorative days; to require the proclamation of Workers Memorial Day; to prohibit the declaration of certain days as paid holidays; and to declare an emergency.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Governor shall annually proclaim April 28 as Workers Memorial Day in remembrance of the courage and integrity of American workers. The Governor shall recommend that Workers Memorial Day be observed in an appropriate manner.

Sec. 2. The observances provided for in sections 84-104.05, 84-104.08, 84-107, and 84-108 and section 1 of this act shall not include provisions for such days to be declared paid holidays pursuant to subsection (3) of section 84-1001.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
