LB1285 creates the Task Force on Supported Employment.

The task force will study the barriers to supporting individuals with intellectual & developmental disabilities in attaining & maintaining employment. The task force will provide recommendations to the Legislature, the Governor, & state agencies.

The task force will consist of the following appointed members:

- Voting members:
  - The chairperson of the Health & Human Services Committee of the Legislature or designee
  - A member of the Appropriations Committee of the Legislature appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council
  - A member of the Business & Labor Committee of the Legislature appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council
  - o A representative of the Governor's office appointed by the Governor
  - o The chief executive officer of the Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) or designee
  - o The executive director of the Nebraska Planning Council on Developmental Disabilities or designee
  - Two service providers with eight or more years of experience & a high success rate in delivering supported employment to individuals with a broad range of disabilities appointed by the Governor
  - A representative of a chamber of commerce appointed by the Governor
  - o Two self-advocates with at least five years of experience in employment appointed by the Governor
  - A certified community work incentives coordinator or community partner work incentives counselor appointed by the Governor
  - A special education transition coordinator appointed by the Commissioner of Education
- Non-voting members:
  - A representative of a Nebraska organization that advocates for the rights of individuals with disabilities appointed by the Governor
  - A representative from the University Center for Excellence in Developmental Disability Education, Research & Service of the Munroe-Meyer Institute at the University of Nebraska Medical Center appointed by the Governor
  - An employee of the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) Vocational Rehabilitation Department appointed by the Commissioner of Education
  - An employee of the Division of Developmental Disabilities of DHHS appointed by the Governor
  - o An employee of the Division of Behavioral Health of DHHS appointed by the Governor
  - An employee of the Department of Labor (NDOL) appointed by the Governor
  - o A supported employment expert who has assisted in other states appointed by the Governor

The task force will submit a report electronically to the Legislature & Governor no later than December 1, 2025.

There could be costs associated with the task force members & when they convene, that cost cannot be determined at this time.
