Introduced by Enrollment and Review Committee: McGill, 26, Chairperson 1. Strike the original sections and all amendments 1 2 thereto and insert the following new sections: 3 Section 1. Section 71-4401, Reissue Revised Statutes of 4 Nebraska, is amended to read: 5 71-4401 For purposes of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act, unless the context otherwise 6 7 requires: 8 (1) Domestic animal shall mean means any dog or cat, and 9 cat shall mean means a cat which is a household pet; (2) Vaccination against rabies shall mean means the 10 inoculation of a domestic or hybrid animal with a rabies vaccine 11 as approved by the rules and regulations adopted and promulgated 12 13 by the Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and 14 Licensure. Such vaccination shall be performed by a veterinarian 15 duly licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of 16 Nebraska; 17 (3) Compendium shall mean means the compendium of animal 18 rabies vaccine as provided by the National Association of State Public Health Veterinarians; 19 20 (4) Department shall mean means the Department of Health 21 and Human Services Regulation and Licensure; 22 (5) Hybrid animal means any animal which is the product 23 of the breeding of a domestic animal with a nondomestic animal;

1 (5) (6) Own, unless otherwise specified, shall mean means 2 to possess, keep, harbor, or have control of, charge of, or custody 3 of a domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animal. This term shall <u>does</u> not apply 4 to domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animals owned by other persons which are 5 temporarily maintained on the premises of a veterinarian or kennel 6 operator for a period of not more than thirty days;

7 (6) (7) Owner shall means any person possessing, 8 keeping, harboring, or having charge or control of any domestic 9 or hybrid animal or permitting any domestic or hybrid animal to 10 habitually be or remain on or be lodged or fed within such person's 11 house, yard, or premises. This term shall does not apply to 12 veterinarians or kennel operators temporarily maintaining on their premises domestic or hybrid animals owned by other persons for a 13 14 period of not more than thirty days; and

15 (7) (8) Rabies control authority shall mean means county, 16 township, city, or village health and law enforcement officials who 17 shall enforce sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of 18 this act relating to the vaccination and impoundment of domestic 19 or hybrid animals. Such public officials shall not be are not 20 responsible for any accident or disease of a domestic <u>or hybrid</u> 21 animal resulting from the enforcement of such sections.

Sec. 2. Section 71-4402, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

24 71-4402 (1) Every domestic animal in the State of 25 Nebraska shall be vaccinated against rabies with a licensed 26 vaccine and shall be revaccinated at intervals specified by 27 rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the department.

Young domestic animals shall be initially vaccinated at the age
 specified in such rules and regulations. Unvaccinated domestic
 animals acquired or moved into the State of Nebraska shall be
 vaccinated within thirty days after purchase or arrival unless
 under the age for initial vaccination.

6 (2) The rabies vaccine used to vaccinate domestic 7 animals pursuant to this section shall be sold only to licensed 8 veterinarians.

9 (3) The department shall adopt and promulgate rules 10 and regulations for the control and prevention of rabies. Such 11 rules and regulations shall generally comply with the compendium 12 and the recommendations of the United States Public Health 13 Service. The department may consider changes in the compendium 14 and recommendations of the United States Public Health Service when 15 adopting and promulgating such rules and regulations.

16 Sec. 3. (1) Every hybrid animal in the State of Nebraska 17 shall be vaccinated against rabies with a licensed vaccine determined scientifically to be reliable in preventing rabies 18 in a hybrid animal and shall be revaccinated at intervals specified 19 by rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the department. 20 21 A young hybrid animal shall be initially vaccinated at the age 22 specified in such rules and regulations. An unvaccinated hybrid 23 animal acquired or moved into the State of Nebraska shall be vaccinated within thirty days after purchase or arrival unless 24 25 under the age for initial vaccination.

26 (2) The rabies vaccine used to vaccinate a hybrid
27 animal pursuant to this section shall be sold only to licensed

1 veterinarians. 2 (3) It is unlawful to own a hybrid animal in this state 3 if no licensed vaccine determined scientifically to be reliable in 4 preventing rabies is available for a hybrid animal. 5 (4) If no licensed vaccine determined scientifically to 6 be reliable in preventing rabies is available for a hybrid animal, 7 an owner of a hybrid animal prior to the effective date of this 8 act may continue to own or harbor such hybrid animal until (a) the 9 hybrid animal dies or physical possession of the hybrid animal is 10 transferred to an owner in another state or (b) one year after the 11 effective date of this act, whichever is shorter, if the hybrid 12 animal is kept by the owner in an enclosure adequate to prevent the 13 escape of the hybrid animal. 14 Sec. 4. The department shall adopt and promulgate rules 15 and regulations for the control and prevention of rabies. Such rules and regulations shall generally comply with the compendium 16 17 and the recommendations of the United States Public Health Service. The department may consider changes in the compendium 18

Section 71-4404, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read: 13 14 71-4404 The cost of rabies vaccination shall be borne by 15 the owner of the domestic or hybrid animal. Sec. 7. Section 71-4405, Reissue Revised Statutes of 16 17 Nebraska, is amended to read: 71-4405 (1) The provisions of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 18 and sections 3 and 4 of this act with respect to vaccination 19 20 shall not apply to any domestic or hybrid animal owned by a 21 person temporarily remaining within the State of Nebraska for less 22 than thirty days, to any domestic or hybrid animal brought into 23 the State of Nebraska for field trial or show purposes, or to 24 any domestic or hybrid animal brought into the state for hunting 25 purposes for a period of less than thirty days. Such domestic or 26 hybrid animals shall be kept under strict supervision of the owner. 27 It shall be unlawful to bring any domestic or hybrid animal into

the State of Nebraska which does not comply with the animal health

4 (2) Domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animals assigned to a research 5 institution or a similar facility shall be exempt from sections 6 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act.

8 Nebraska, is amended to read:

9 71-4406 (1) Any animal which is owned by a person and has 10 bitten any person or caused an abrasion of the skin of any person 11 shall be seized by the rabies control authority for a period of not 12 less than ten days if:

(a) The animal is suspected of having rabies, regardless
of the species and whether or not the animal has been vaccinated;

15 (b) The animal is not vaccinated and is of a species
16 determined by the department to be a rabid species; or

17 (c) The animal is of a species which has been determined 18 by the department to be a rabid species not amenable to rabies 19 protection by immunization, whether or not such animal has been 20 vaccinated.

21 If, after observation and examination by a veterinarian, 22 at the end of the ten-day period the animal shows no clinical signs 23 of rabies, the animal may be released to its owner.

(2) (a) Except as provided in subdivision (b) of this
subsection, whenever any person has been bitten or has an abrasion
of the skin caused by an animal owned by another person, which
animal has been vaccinated in accordance with section 71-4402 and

section 3 of this act, or if such injury to a person is caused by 1 2 an owned animal determined by the department to be a rabid species 3 amenable to rabies protection by immunization which has been 4 vaccinated, such animal shall be confined by the owner or other 5 responsible person as required by the rabies control authority for a period of at least ten days and shall be observed and examined by 6 7 a veterinarian at the end of such ten-day period. If no clinical 8 signs of rabies are found by the veterinarian, such animal may be 9 released from confinement.

10 (b) A vaccinated animal owned by a law enforcement or 11 governmental military agency which bites or causes an abrasion of 12 the skin of any person during training or the performance of the animal's duties may be confined as provided in subdivision (a) of 13 14 this subsection. Such agency shall maintain ownership of and shall 15 control and supervise the actions of such animal for a period of 16 fifteen days following such injury. If during such period the death 17 of the animal occurs for any reason, a veterinarian shall within 18 twenty-four hours of the death examine the tissues of the animal 19 for clinical signs of rabies.

20 (3) Any animal of a rabid species which has bitten a 21 person or caused an abrasion of the skin of a person and which 22 is unowned or the ownership of which cannot be determined within 23 seventy-two hours of the time of the bite or abrasion shall be 24 immediately subject to any tests which the department believes are 25 necessary to determine whether the animal is afflicted with rabies. 26 The seventy-two-hour period shall include holidays and weekends 27 and shall not be extended for any reason. The tests required by

1 this subsection may include tests which require the animal to be 2 destroyed.

5 71-4407 In the case of domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animals known 6 to have been bitten by a rabid animal, the following rules shall 7 apply:

8 (1) If the bitten or exposed domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animal 9 has not been vaccinated in accordance with section 71-4402<u> and</u> 10 <u>section 3 of this act</u>, such bitten or exposed domestic <u>or hybrid</u> 11 animal shall be immediately destroyed unless the owner is willing 12 to place such domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animal in strict isolation in a 13 kennel under veterinary supervision for a period of not less than 14 six months; and

15 (2) If the bitten or exposed domestic or hybrid animal has been vaccinated in accordance with section 71-4402 and section 16 17 3 of this act, such domestic or hybrid animal shall be subject to 18 the following procedure: (a) Such domestic or hybrid animal shall 19 be immediately revaccinated and confined for a period of not less than thirty days following vaccination; (b) if such domestic or 20 21 hybrid animal is not immediately revaccinated, such domestic or 22 hybrid animal shall be confined in strict isolation in a kennel 23 for a period of not less than six months under the supervision of a veterinarian; or (c) such domestic or hybrid animal shall be 24 25 destroyed if the owner does not comply with either subdivision (a) 26 or (b) of this subdivision.

3 animal pound or pounds or may enter into a cooperative agreement
4 with a licensed veterinarian for the establishment and operation of
5 a pound.

6 (2) Any dog or hybrid of the family Canidae found 7 outside the owner's premises whose owner does not possess a valid 8 certificate of rabies vaccination and valid rabies vaccination 9 tag for such dog or hybrid of the family Canidae shall be 10 impounded. The rabies control authority may require the impoundment 11 of domestic or hybrid animals other than dogs or hybrids of the 12 family Canidae. All impounded domestic or hybrid animals shall be given proper care, treatment, and maintenance. Each impounded 13 14 domestic or hybrid animal shall be kept and maintained at the pound 15 for a period of not less than seventy-two hours unless reclaimed 16 earlier by the owner.

17 (3) Notice of impoundment of all animals, including any 18 significant marks of identification, shall be posted at the pound 19 as public notification of impoundment. Any unvaccinated domestic or hybrid animal may be reclaimed by its owner during the period of 20 21 impoundment by payment of prescribed pound fees and by complying 22 with the rabies vaccination requirement of sections 71-4401 to 23 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act within seventy-two hours of release. Any vaccinated domestic or hybrid animal impounded 24 25 because its owner has not presented a valid certificate of rabies 26 vaccination and a valid rabies vaccination tag for such domestic 27 or hybrid animal may be reclaimed by its owner by furnishing proof

of rabies vaccination and payment of all impoundment fees prior to
 release.

(4) At the expiration of impoundment, a domestic or 3 4 hybrid animal may be claimed by payment of established pound 5 fees and by compliance with the rabies vaccination requirement of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act within 6 7 seventy-two hours of release. If the domestic or hybrid animal is 8 unclaimed at the end of five days, the authorities may dispose of 9 the domestic or hybrid animal in accordance with applicable laws or 10 rules and regulations.

13 71-4409 The rabies control authority shall enforce
14 sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act.

15 In the event that the health and law enforcement 16 officials of a county, township, city, or village fail to act 17 with sufficient promptness in enforcing sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act, the department may take all 18 19 actions necessary for the proper administration and enforcement of 20 such sections relating to vaccination and impoundment of domestic 21 or hybrid animals. In such a case no authorized representatives 22 of the department or any law enforcement officials enforcing such 23 sections shall be responsible for any accident or disease of a 24 domestic or hybrid animal resulting from the enforcement of such 25 sections.

1 71-4410 The owner of any domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animal or any 2 person who violates any of the provisions of sections 71-4401 to 3 71-4412 <u>and sections 3 and 4 of this act</u> shall be guilty of a Class 4 V misdemeanor. When the owner of any domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animal or 5 other animal fails or refuses to comply with section 71-4406 or 6 71-4407, the rabies control authority shall obtain an order for 7 seizure of such animal pursuant to Chapter 29, article 8.

9 Nebraska, is amended to read:

10 71-4412 In the State of Nebraska, all laws, ordinances, 11 codes, or rules and regulations concerning the control of rabies or 12 the vaccination of domestic <u>or hybrid</u> animals against rabies shall 13 be enforced by the county, township, city, and village health and 14 law enforcement officials or those other officers with regulatory 15 authority as specified by the governing political subdivisions.

16 Whenever a county, township, city, or village requires 17 the licensure of domestic or hybrid animals, it may require that, 18 before a license is issued for the possession or maintenance of any 19 domestic or hybrid animal in any such county, township, city, or village, the owner or keeper of the domestic or hybrid animal shall 20 21 furnish to the clerk of such political subdivision a certification 22 that the domestic or hybrid animal has been vaccinated against 23 rabies in accordance with sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 and sections 3 and 4 of this act. 24
