Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 403 would have required a different distribution of state motor vehicle sales tax receipts in any future year in which the state may have a sales tax of greater than 5.5 percent. In the event that the state would have implemented a sales tax rate greater than 5.5 percent, the yield from the

sales tax on motor vehicles over 5.5 percent would have been required to be distributed on a per capita basis to counties and cities.

The bill would have also changed provisions requiring sales taxes collected on motor vehicles that are in excess of five percent to be deposited in the Highway Allocation Fund. Under the bill, these sales taxes would have been deposited in the Highway Trust Fund.
