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Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 714 would have amended section 77-2716, adjustments to federal adjusted gross income for Nebraska tax purposes, to exclude any social security benefits that are taxable federally. Section 2 would have amended section 77-3504, definitions under the homestead exemption act, to exclude from the definition of household income any social security that is <u>excluded</u> for federal tax purposes. The income tax change was operative for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2008 and the homestead change was operative beginning in 2009.
