A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to fire and rescue departments; to amend
 section 35-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
 change provisions relating to clothing and equipment and
 certain donations; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
 the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) A person who donates fire control or

- 2 rescue equipment to a fire department or a political subdivision
- 3 for use by its fire department shall not be liable for civil
- 4 damages for personal injuries, property damage or loss, or death
- 5 caused by the fire control or rescue equipment after donation,
- 6 except for injury, damage, loss, or death caused by the donor's
- 7 intentional or reckless conduct or gross negligence.
- 8 (2) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to a
- 9 vendor or manufacturer of fire control or rescue equipment.
- 10 (3) For purposes of this section:
- 11 (a) Fire control or rescue equipment means any vehicle,
- 12 equipment, tool, communications equipment, or protective gear used
- in firefighting, rescue services, or emergency medical services;
- 14 (b) Fire department means any paid or volunteer fire
- 15 department, company, association, or organization or first-aid,
- 16 rescue, or emergency squad serving a city, village, county,
- 17 township, or rural or suburban fire protection district or any
- 18 other public or private fire department; and
- (c) Person means any individual, corporation, business
- 20 trust, estate, trust, partnership, limited liability company,
- 21 association, joint venture, fire department, public corporation,
- 22 other legal or commercial entity, or governmental subdivision,
- 23 agency, or instrumentality.
- 24 Sec. 2. Section 35-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 25 Nebraska, is amended to read:

1 35-801 (1) No person vendor or manufacturer shall

- 2 knowingly transfer, sell, or offer for sale in this state to any
- 3 fire department or firefighter any item of clothing or equipment
- 4 designed and intended to protect firefighters from death or injury
- 5 while fighting fires unless the item of clothing or equipment meets
- 6 or exceeds the minimum standards established for such item of
- 7 clothing or equipment by the National Fire Protection Association
- 8 in effect at the time of such transfer, sale, or offer for sale.
- 9 (2) No fire department shall knowingly purchase and no
- 10 fire department or firefighter shall knowingly accept from any
- 11 vendor or manufacturer any item of clothing or equipment intended
- 12 to protect firefighters from death or injury while fighting fires
- 13 unless the item of clothing or equipment meets or exceeds the
- 14 minimum standards established for such item of clothing or
- 15 equipment by the National Fire Protection Association in effect
- 16 at the time of such purchase or acceptance.
- 17 (3) Any person violating subsection (1) or (2) of this
- 18 section shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor.
- 19 (4) For purposes of this section:
- 20 (a) Clothing or equipment shall not include station or
- 21 work uniforms or other items of personal clothing worn or intended
- 22 to be worn under protective clothing or equipment while fighting
- 23 fires; and
- 24 (b) Fire department shall include means any paid or
- 25 volunteer fire department, company, association, or organization

1 or first-aid, rescue, or emergency squad serving a city, village,

- 2 county, township, or rural or suburban fire protection district, or
- 3 <u>any</u>other public or private fire department.
