A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to accountants; to amend section 1-136.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 1-124, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to change provisions relating to a reciprocal certificate as a certified public accountant and an experience requirement; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 1-124, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 1-124 (1)(a) The board may, in its discretion, waive the examination described in section 1-114 and may issue a reciprocal 4 5 certificate as a certified public accountant to any person who possesses the qualifications specified in subdivision (1) (a) or 6 7 (2) (a) of section 1-114 and section 1-116 and who is the holder 8 of a certificate as a certified public accountant, then in full 9 force and effect, issued under the laws of any state or is the 10 holder of a certificate, license, or degree in a foreign country 11 constituting a recognized qualification for the practice of public 12 accountancy in such country, comparable to that of a certified 13 public accountant of this state, which is then in full force and 14 effect.

15 (b) The board shall waive the examination described in 16 section 1-114 and the educational requirements specified in section 17 1-116 and shall issue a reciprocal certificate as a certified 18 public accountant to any person who possesses the qualifications 19 specified in subdivision (2)(a) of section 1-114, who is the holder 20 of a certificate as a certified public accountant, then in full 21 force and effect, issued under the laws of any state, who meets 22 all other current requirements of the board for issuance of a 23 certificate as a certified public accountant, and who, at the time 24 of the application for a reciprocal certificate as a certified 25 public accountant, has had, within the ten years immediately

1 preceding application, at least four years' experience in the 2 practice of public accountancy specified in subsection (1) of 3 section 1-136.02.

4 <u>(2)</u> The board shall charge each person obtaining 5 a reciprocal certificate issued under this section a fee as 6 established by the board not to exceed four hundred dollars.

7 Sec. 2. Section 1-136.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of

9 1-136.02 (1) The board shall issue a permit under
10 subdivision (1)(a) of section 1-136 to a holder of a certificate of
11 as a certified public accountant when such holder has had:

public accounting experience 12 (a) Two years of 13 satisfactory to the board, in any state, (i) in practice as 14 a certified public accountant or a public accountant, (ii) in 15 employment as a staff accountant by anyone engaging in the practice 16 of public accountancy, or (iii) in any combination of either of 17 such types of experience;

(b) Three years of auditing experience satisfactory to
the board in the office of the Auditor of Public Accounts or in the
Department of Revenue; or

(c) Experience gained through employment by the federal government as a special agent or an internal revenue agent in the Internal Revenue Service, a degree from a college or university of recognized standing, and certification by a District Director of Internal Revenue that such person has had at least three and

one-half years of field experience as a special agent or internal
 revenue agent.

3 (2) The board may <u>shall</u> issue a permit under subdivision 4 (1)(a) of section 1-136 to a holder of a reciprocal certificate 5 issued under section 1-124 upon a showing that:

6 (a) He or she meets all current requirements in this
7 state for issuance of a permit at the time the application is made;
8 or and

9 (b) At the time of the application for a permit the 10 applicant, within the ten years immediately preceding application, 11 has had at least five years two years' experience outside this 12 state in the practice of public accountancy as a sole proprietor or 13 as a staff accountant.

Sec. 3. Original section 1-136.02, Reissue Revised
Statutes of Nebraska, and section 1-124, Revised Statutes
Cumulative Supplement, 2006, are repealed.

Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effectwhen passed and approved according to law.
